### Celebrating University Publishing

Last spring we decided to celebrate the vitality of university press feminist publishing with a special University Press Issue of FBN. We wrote to university publishers asking for catalogs, new book announcements, odd trivia and advertising and received many enthusiastic re-sponses. We solicited special articles and columns for the issue, merged it all together and ended up with a special double issue on university press pub-lishing. Our subscribers were delighted.
